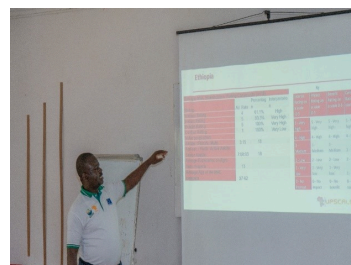
UPSCALE's project partners Shem Kuyah participated as speakers in the high-level panel discussions. This was an incredible opportunity to promote the project and its results.
